Have your child at the field at least 15 minutes prior to the game time listed above. The team listed first wears the blue side of the jersey. If your child is unable to attend the game, please call your child's coach prior to the game. SHIN GUARDS are required to be worn to ALL practices and games. No jewelry is allowed unless of religious significance. In the event of a recent ear piercing, parents may completely tape over earrings. Please advise your child's coach of any food allergies or medical considerations. If a child takes medication, please be sure to have it on hand at every game in the event it is needed. Parents need to administer any medications needed. MCSA would like the parents to enjoy the game as much as the children, therefore we ask parents and/or visitors to yell only POSITIVE encouragement to the players during the game.

**COACHES:** Coaches are permitted on the field during the game to help direct players during the game in the U6 age group. Field size is 25 X 35. There are four 6 minute quarters in each game. Opposing teams will switch sides at half-time. There will be three players on the field per side with NO GOALIE. Players should be rotated around so that they do not play in the same position. Substitutions may only be made at quarter breaks unless player is injured. All kicks are indirect. The team listed first on the schedule will wear the blue side of the jersey and the coach will provide the game balls. Please make sure your team is correctly dressed and ready for the referee's inspection - shirt's tucked in, shin guards in place, and appropriate tennis shoes or cleats are being worn. Socks must be worn over the shin guards. Anyone with pierced ears should have earrings removed or in the event of a recent piercing, completely taped over. No other jewelry is to be worn unless of religious significance.

\*\*\* In the event one of teams does not have enough players for both fields, the first option is to borrow players from the other team. If neither teams has enough to man both fields, the next option will be to utilize only one of the fields playing 3 v 3. Any more than three players on the field must be authorized by the referee coordinator or the U6 Age group coordinator. Maximum allowed in the event of the request being granted is 4 v 4.
